The tournament will be played in full accordance with the Laws of Badminton (see <http://www.internationalbadminton.org>, the Competition Regulations (see <http://www.internationalbadminton.org>), and the tournament is also played according to the Junior Circuit Instructions. In the event of any dispute, the Referee's decision shall be final.

## 2. Entries

- a. Competitors shall be members of clubs belonging to an organisation in membership with the BWF. **Participation is restricted to players born in 1991 or later.** (This is the same age limit as for the German Junior).
- b. **The number of entries per country** (except for the Netherlands) **is restricted** to 8 entries per singles event, and 6 entries per doubles event. Entries must be done in order of strength.
- c. Entry forms must reach the BC Duinwijck Tournament Committee at [tournament@dutchjunior.nl](mailto:tournament@dutchjunior.nl) , c/o Mrs. Henriëtte Vernooy Vogelenzangseweg 180, 2114 BB Vogelenzang, The Netherlands, by Saturday, FEBRAURY 10, 2009. Entries by e-mail will be acknowledged; if you do not receive an acknowledgement within 5 days, please contact the tournament secretariat.
- d. Competitors and officials, who need visa for the Netherlands, should send an **application for visa not later than January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009**, to the Tournament Committee. **We cannot accept entries needing visa without such an application.**
- e. A maximum of 250 matches will be accepted in the main event, there is no qualification; if necessary, entries will be selected according to strength.
- f. Entry fees (to be paid prior to the tournament) are €20,00 per competitor for the singles, and €30,00 per pair for the doubles.
- g. Both seeding and draw will be done by Badminton Europe
- h. When none of the events has at least 12 competitors (8 in women's) the tournament is cancelled. If an event (due to late incoming withdrawals) has less than 12 competitors (8 in women's doubles), this event shall be played but shall not count towards any Circuit ranking.

### 3. System of play

All events will be played according to a knockout system.

### 4. Match conditions

- a. Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the entry form.  
No exception will be made to this rule.
- b. Yonex Aerosensa 50 shuttlecocks will be used exclusively. Shuttles will be free of charge.
- c. An umpire will be appointed for each match.
- d. During the tournament, a physiotherapist will be available for the competitors, free of charge.

### 5. Clothing and advertising

Clothing worn by players during play shall be acceptable badminton sports clothing. Each article of clothing may be of any colour or combinations of colours. From the quarterfinals it is recommended that doubles partners wear the same colour and opposing players or pairs wear different colours from each other.

*The shirt* may carry advertising as defined below:

- a. Up to three adverts each of 20 square centimetres or less, on the following locations: left sleeve, right sleeve, left collar, right collar, front of the shirt;
- b. Advertising contained in a band of uniform width not exceeding 10 centimetres; such a band may be at any angle and may be on the front of the shirt, the back of the shirt or both;
- c. If, in the Referee's sole judgement, there is a clash between the content of the advertising in 5.b and the event sponsors or TV broadcasters, or if the content of the advertising would infringe local laws or be considered offensive, then the Referee may limit advertising on the shirt to 5.a.

*Other clothing:*

- d. Each sock and each shoe may carry two adverts provided they are 20 square cm or less.
- e. Each other article of clothing may carry one advert of 20 square cm or less.
- f. The adverts in 5.a till 5.e may be the clothing manufacturer's emblem or that of any sponsor. Lettering and designs on player's clothing:
- g. The back of the shirt may carry the name of the player or country, complying with BWF Competition Regulation 23; the shirt may carry on the front the flag or national emblem of the country represented. The name on the back of the shirt is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals." (reg. 18.2). The back of the shirt may carry the country. The shirt may carry on the front the flag or national emblem of the country represented. It is mandatory for semi-finals and finals that double partners wear the same colour" (reg. 18.3).
- h. Abstract designs containing no advertising, commercial or promotional content are permitted;
- i. A design or lettering is allowed when it forms part of an advert permitted by Condition 5a till 5f and falls wholly within the permitted dimensions.
